*Chairman Mariette Ross called the meeting to order at 4:06 p.m.*

Chocorua Lake  
Parking Area

The Board met with Mr. Tom Peters to review the information from Town Counsel regarding the parking area ordinance that has been requested for Chocorua Lake. The Board informed Mr. Peters that they would be placing part of the ordinance into the new traffic and road regulations policy that would be worked on later in the meeting. Mr. Peters was informed the Town is not currently plowing that roadway and that the road was considered a class V road that is maintained in the summer. Mr. Peters was advised the roadway could not be closed, as it was a class V road, unless voted on at Town Meeting. Mr. Peters accepted the information from the Board with no indication whether or not a warrant article would be coming in for the 2006 Town Meeting.

Traffic & Road  
Regulations Policy

The Board reviewed and amended the proposed traffic and road regulations policy with Police Chief Poirier, Bruce Robinson and Steve Solomon's in attendance. Chief Poirier questioned why this was being discussed as most of the regulation being presented is State law and already taken care of by the RSAs? The Board indicated they felt the need for a policy for the Town of Tamworth.

Mrs. Pearce was given the changes to make prior to this policy being reviewed at a future meeting.

Administrative  
Issues

Mrs. Pearce reviewed the following with the Board:

1. It was announced that the sled dog races scheduled for the upcoming weekend had been cancelled due to the weather and ice conditions.
2. The Board discussed an application to build on map/lot 206-030. The Board indicated the property owner did not have to go to the Planning Board, as there is already a building on the lot. The Board requested the landowner sign a waiver.
3. *Mariette Ross moved and David Haskell supported applying for a grant for the rescue squad in the amount of \$18,788 for radios. Vote was unanimous. Motion passed.*
4. *Mariette Ross moved and David Haskell supported accepting the minutes of January 9 and January 19, 2006 as written. Vote was unanimous. Motion passed.*
5. Anne Abear discussed RSA 656:40 presented from David Haskell regarding the use of a voting machine. Mrs. Abear advised that after conversations with the Secretary of States office, the equipment Tamworth was going to rent for the upcoming



Town Meeting elections should be adequate; the machine has been approved by the ballot law commission. Mrs. Abear will check with the rental company.

Non-Public Session

*Mariette Ross moved and David Haskell supported at 5:39 p.m. to enter into a non-public session with Anne Abear and Cassandra Pearce per RSA 91-A: 3II, c (matters which if discussed in public session would likely effect adversely the reputation of any person other than a member of the Board).
