**Police Department**

Chief Poirier gave the board the Police Log for the month of May 2008. He requested to order two new phones to replace the old one. Chief Poirier informed the board that Ptl. Penny Frechette will be starting on Monday and gave a brief update regarding her schooling. Jim Bowditch asked where does the Broadband Computer access status stand for the Village. The board informed him that there where a few private individuals working on it and they haven't come up with a package or finances at this time.
