

Town of Tamworth
Board of Selectmen's Meeting
March 17, 2009
Town Highway Garage

Selectmen John Roberts and William Farnum met with Road Agent Bruce Robinson at the highway garage on March 17, 2009 at 7:00 AM.

Discussion was held on the location for the container at the highway garage. The site will be staked off by Mr. Robinson to stay at least 25 feet from the wetland. Closer to the garage is a preferable site if it will fit. The second location recommended is just east of the fuel tank.

Whittier Road paving was disused and Mr. Robinson will measure the road up for the amount of gravel that might be needed.

The need to move the stone and loam piles to be able to screen more sand was discussed. Mr. Robinson will look at the different places that the material could be placed and offered to crush a few loads of the stone to see what grade of crush it will make. It will be returned and used in the yard around the garage. The bank by the entrance will be graded to a better slope and loamed and seeded. The apron off Chinook Trail (Route 113A) will need to be paved per the state driveway permit that was issued. The second entrance south of this new entrance is to be blocked off and seeded.

Mr. Robinson is still attempting to locate a broom for the loader.

Mr. Robinson will ask Chris Money Penny at Ossipee Auto about the cabinets for the town garage.

There was discussion about security at the town garage, a gate was proposed, after discussion it was concluded that cameras were a better choice, as they would capture who was there and a gate would only keep the honest people out.
