

## TAMWORTH MASTER PLAN MINUTES

For Wednesday, August 27, 2008

### Master Plan Document

The Master Plan document is almost completed. Formatting of a few chapters and pagination of the document are among the things that need to be done.

Some chapters have been dropped off at the community mailbox at The Other Store. These include Economic Development, Natural Hazards, Regional Concerns, and Housing.

The Economic Development chapter will be given to John Cleveland for completion.

Other areas that need work are Community Facilities, Maps, and Bibliography.

Lianne Prentice will send the Land Use section to Tom Peters.

Maud Anderson and Lianne Prentice will work on the unfinished chapters and do a final overall check of the document for consistency. Since the next Planning Board meeting is September 24, 2008, the editing of the document should be done before then.

Lianne Prentice will sum up the editing process in a separate document, highlighting the lessons learned, what went well, and what did not go so well.

The Master Plan draft should be completed before the September 24, 2008 Planning Board Meeting.

The next meeting of the Tamworth Master Plan Committee will be a joint session with the Tamworth Planning Board on Wednesday, September 24, 2008, at the Tamworth Town Offices.
