The minutes of January 5, 2009 were reviewed with the following corrections by Tom Cleveland;

Sixth paragraph, replace the first and with **to**.

Dom Bergin moved to approve the minutes as amended seconded by Bryan Berling, all were in favor.

In reviewing the list of ordinances, in the Town Clerk's records William Farnum found the following old regulations by-laws policies and by-laws;

Passed at a special selectmen's meeting June 25, 1963, it is unlawful to deposit sewage in the town dump.

Town meeting 1986 Article 52 oppose the burial, storage, transportation and production of high level radioactive waste in the Town of Tamworth....

Passed at a special Town Meeting in August 1989 Article 3 To see if the town will vote pursuant to RSA 160-A:2-a to prohibit the issuance of permits for the sale of fireworks with in the Town of Tamworth.

A list of all the collected items will be sent by William Farnum to Bryan Berling so that he can make an electronic data base.

Bryan Berling will also bring in the revised chart showing who is who at the next meeting.

The next step for committee is to make a book with all of the information collected and have that information in a searchable data base. Hyperlinks to each printed ordinance, policy, by-law, and or regulation will need to be established.

It was discussed how to get a final book with just the items that would be enforceable that could be kept up to date. It was understood that the committee at some point would need to vote on what they felt was a certifiable copy of the book of ordinances, regulations, by-law, policies. There was discussion on how the old outdated items could be removed and at what point we might need town council to assist us.

The next meeting is set for March 2, 2009 at the town office building at 7PM.
