

Town of Tamworth Transfer & Recycling Station

Days of Operation Wednesday, Saturday, and Sunday
Operation Hours are from 9 am to 5 pm

Dumping by permit only- A Transfer Station Permit sticker
or Non Resident Temporary Permit.

DIRECTIONS to facility: The Transfer Station is located at
557 Bearcamp Highway (Rte 25)
From the intersection of 16 & 25 it is 3.3 miles
on the left hand side, and from the intersection
of 113 and 25 it is 1 mile on the right hand side.

The Following Must be Recycled:

- Aluminum cans - (Beverage cans only)
- Steel and other cans
- Glass
- Corrugated cardboard - must be flattened (no waxed cardboard or pizza boxes)
- Brown paper bags
- Batteries – all rechargeable
- Newspaper
- Magazines & Catalogs
- Paper Products
- Plastics
- Brush (5" diameter max.)
- White Goods: (Washers, Dryers, Ranges, Water heaters, etc.)

All tops/caps must be removed ~ Items should be empty
Labels do not have to be removed ~ Items do not need to be crushed

There is a minimum charge of \$3.00 for any item placed in a container.

The following will not be accepted anywhere in the Transfer Station:

Hazardous Waste-Stumps-Pine Needles-Lawn Clippings-Leaves
Other Yard & Garden Debris, Propane Cylinders, Automobile Batteries
& Animal and/or Human Waste.

**Scrap Metals
Recycling Guidelines**

Acceptable:

White Goods: (Washers, Dryers, Ranges, Water heaters, etc.)
Units with Freon include a fee (see fee schedule)

Not Acceptable:

Wires/Cables over 4' in length

Commingled Containers Recycling Guidelines

Plastic

Acceptable:

- Plastics #'s 1,2,3,5 &7 (look on the Bottom to Identify)
- Soft Drink and Liquor Bottles
- Oil and Anti-Freeze Containers
- Milk, Water, Juice Containers
- Laundry, Bleach, and Cleaning Containers

Not Acceptable:

- Plastics #'s 4 & 6
- Grocery Bags, Sandwich Bags
- Five Gallon Pails (unless cut up)
- Lids and Caps
- Brittle Dairy Food Containers
- Needles

Glass

Acceptable:

- Ceramic and Porcelain Cups and Plates
- Drinking Glasses, Stemware
- Heat Resistant Ovenware
- Vases
- Mirror and Windowpane Glass

Not Acceptable:

- Light Bulbs

Commingled Containers Recycling Guidelines

Metals

Acceptable:

- Steel (Tin and Soup Cans)
- Aluminum, Pie Tins and Foil
- Aerosol Cans (Empty)
- Non-Paint or Pesticide

Not Acceptable:

- Paint Cans, Gasoline Cans
- Any Container that has Previously Contained a Hazardous or Toxic Material

How to Prepare Commingled Containers for Collection

- All containers must be rinsed and free of all contaminants. Items you place in your bin do not need to be scrubbed clean and labels do not need to be removed.
- Any removable corks, tops, rings, metal bottleneck wraps should be removed prior to recycling.
- Flatten containers whenever possible to allow more room in your recycling container and in recycling truck.
- Do not worry about broken glass or plate. Just place it in your bin and recycle it.

How to Prepare Mixed Paper for Collection

- Remove or empty all plastic bags
- Remove any Non-Acceptable items and discard with your regular trash
- Place mixed papers in any brown paper bag, or bundle with string
- Keep your paper separate from cans, plastics, and glass. Please do not mix them together.
