The report was reorganized this year. The warrant articles were moved to the front. Page 5 shows the breakdown of capital expenses by department for the entire 6 year period. The School Bond is paid off in 2022, so in 2023 there is no school bond payment, and in 2023 there is no transfer station payment.

Steve Gray – as a taxpayer, this is an overwhelmingly great service to the taxpayers of the Town.

John Wheeler has a question on page 5 – diagram – there is a typo in the number

Page 7 – transfer station- description needed - leave as is

Steve Gray - Would the CIP consider property that could house the highway department and be mined for sanding materials - perhaps 10 years down the road, due to the savings that came from the materials mined. Also, would the CIP consider advising the Selectmen to use monies from the unexpended emergency fund balance to reduce taxes, perhaps \$25 - \$30000.

John made a motion to approve the minutes from 8/29/17. David seconded. APPROVED
