Minutes of Tamworth Trustees of Cemeteries 5:00 PM November 24 2015 At Cook Memorial Library

Members Present: Mark Albee, John Roberts, and John Wheeler

- 1) The minutes of 9/8/15 & 10/6/15 meetings were approved.
- 2) The current budget was reviewed. We will be under budget overall, but over on maintenance. The tree removal at Pease has been completed.
- 3) The transfer of Virginia Harlan plots A-3 and A-4 in the Coville west section of Chocorua to her sons was approved and signed.
- 4) A request was received from D. Cobb concerning the lots of her grandparents, Bertha and Fred Hammond, in the old section of Chocorua cemetery. She and her sister, Sandra Akacem need to send notarized letters to us indicating that they are the sole survivors of the Hammonds and that they approve of Cobb burying the ashes of Cobb, her husband, and her son, and placing surface memorials.
- 5) Tim Brown received approval for the Scouts to scrape and paint the Riverside cemetery shed as requested by Lisa Santa Marie, who will pay for such.
- 6) Richard Clark wrote for approval to have the lilacs removed from around his parents' graves at Wonalancet. Approval was granted. However, when looking at the map and lot records, it appears there is a discrepancy between the map location and the deed. L-22 is on the records, but shown vacant on the map with apparently L-21 listed as Clark. Wheeler will contact Clark to see if he has a copy of the deed.
- 7) A draft petition for the placing of an article on the Town Meeting warrant to establish a cemetery expendable maintenance trust fund and to authorize funds received from the sale of cemetery lots in said fund, was reviewed and revised.
- 8) The outstanding cemetery items list was reviewed. Paul King will research the ownership of the Pease Cemetery soon, but does not expect to get to the surveying there and at Chocorua until next year. Mark will contact Rob Wallace of that delay.
- 9) Mark reported Jack (Robert) Delude was recently buried in lot B-5 of the Fowlers Mills Cemetery.
- 10) Roberts reported he had a call from Ann Port, daughter of Roff Spicer, indicating she may be burying the ashes of her son in the Spicer plot in the Damon section of Ordination Rock cemetery.
- 11) The Cook Library has tentatively scheduled a presentation by the NH Old graveyard Association for March 30 at 7 PM. We will be listed as a co-sponsor and share the information with the 250th committee.
- 12) The next meeting will be January 12 at 5 PM.
