

Minutes of  
Tamworth Trustees of Cemeteries  
5 PM November 19, 2014  
At Cook Memorial Library

Members Present: Mark Albee, John Wheeler and John Roberts

- 1) Minutes of the 10/28/14 meetings were approved.
- 2) There was a discussion concerning the possibility of giving an honorarium to Jesse for the cemetery monument restoration days. John R indicated one had been given to her privately this year and that he felt the Town/Trustees could not give such. Mark was very interested in giving such. It was agreed not to give one this year and John W would make inquiries with Cassandra and NHMA as to the legalities, insurance, and precedent.
- 3) A request from James Bittick of Sykesville, MD for a fifty year extension of the deed for his lots A-1 and A-2 in the Chocorua Coville west Cemetery was received by John W who wrote up such for him, which the Trustees signed.
- 4) John W will attend a 1:30, 12/1 budget meeting with the Board of Selectmen
- 5) Mark has been in contact with the road Agent re brush cutting in the Coville additions, using up to \$3000 available in our budget. Richard expects to do it, weather permitting, this year.
- 6) Linda Cooke had been in touch with us with concerns about the lack of flags placed in the Bunker Hill Road cemeteries and a tree down in one of them. Mark reported the tree had been removed the day after the call. John W reported that Dave Haskell said in the past flags had been placed on veteran graves in all the cemeteries. Mark had understood from Dave originally, that the Trustees were responsible for only the Town owned cemeteries and had had the boy and girl scouts place them. Mark will work with Dave to see if the Veterans Committee can be responsible for the placement other than the main town cemeteries.
- 7) Mark reported the Town Pound work, other than the Gate, has been done
- 8) John W reported he had been contacted by Michael Amerault that his mother had died and was to be buried in Coville East next week.
- 9) John W reported the Trustees of Trust Funds had decided to use Mackensen & Co to invest the trust funds in order to provide capital growth and better income over the long run.
- 10) Approximately one dozen people showed up at the monument cleaning and repair session November 1 at Riverside.
- 11) Richard Karsok has requested we place corner markers for his lot A-27 in Ordination Rock.
- 12) John W will send a thank you to the Bearcamp garden club for their planting and maintenance of the flowers at the veterans' memorial.
- 13) The next meeting was scheduled for Tuesday, January 6, 2015 at 5 PM at the Library.

The meeting adjourned at 6:20 PM.
