- 1. The minutes of 11/05/19 meeting were approved with the correction of spelling "Read".
- 2. John reported the Selectmen had approved encumbering \$3000 from the 2019 budget for Bill Read's work on Riverside fence and Stevenson gate. Bill has been told he can start work.
- 3. Plans for the new section of Pease Hill Cemetery have been received. Members are to review it with the original sketch. John has asked for a right of way description that can be recorded.
- 4. Deed for M-30 at Ordination Rock to the Dyrenforths' has been singed and check received.
- 5. A draft of the 2019 report by Mark was reviewed. John will type up and get to the Trustees for final review and submission.
- 6. Bruno mentioned Art Mason had asked about getting the overgrown trees removed at the east end of Riverside cemetery near a Mason monument. Bruno will do some more research to determine whose plot the trees might be on and see if there are relatives around who might remove them or approve the removal.
- 7. In a follow-up to the decision to prohibit fake flowers and decorations, John is to draft a change to the R&R to make clear that no glass is allowed. Any fake decorations placed at the time of internment shall be subject to removal after 60 days.
- 8. John has updated cemetery maps with the names of new owners and will get copies for members and the Town Office.
- 9. The next meeting will be Wednesday, March 24, 2020 at 5 PM at Cook Library.
