- 1. Doc Lowe met with the Board to discuss the damage done to an angel that he places on plot A-23 or A-24 at the Wonalancet Cemetery. The lots are owned by Manfredi, a relative. He had met with Mark at the plot and was concerned that the trustees appeared to be putting their contractor's word before his as a town resident. The angel is placed seasonally on the plot and has been broken twice before. It is made of concrete with steel reinforcing that has rusted as water got into concrete over the years. A wing had been broken off. Doc felt that must have been done by the maintenance crew, and he wanted the Trustees to forward a repair bill to her insurance company. We expressed our regrets that the accident had happened. We indicated we would take it under advisement, but pointed out that the Cemetery Rules and Regulations require monuments to be made of natural material and that we are not responsible for damage to monuments. Doc left at 6:20. John is to draft letters to Doc and Tracie Antolin, pointing out the R&R and passing on the bill if she or her insurance company wish to pay it.
