

Adoption of the Master Plan

This plan has been prepared in accordance with all applicable state statutes. Specifically New Hampshire Revised Statutes Annotated (NH RSA) 672:1 (I-IV):

- I. Planning, zoning and related regulations have been and should continue to be the responsibility of municipal government;
- II. Zoning, subdivision regulations and related regulations are a legislative tool that enables municipal government to meet more effectively the demands of evolving and growing communities;
- III. Proper regulations enhance the public health, safety and general welfare and encourage the appropriate and wise use of land;
- IV. The citizens of a municipality should be actively involved in directing the growth of their community.

The Tamworth Master Plan of 2008 fulfills the requirements described in NH RSA 674:1 through 674:3, as revised and amended through July 2007.

The Planning Board of the Town of Tamworth, New Hampshire, in accordance with the provisions of NH RSA 674:4 and 675:6, does hereby adopt the Tamworth Master Plan of 2008, including its findings, recommendations, goals and policies; rescinding and replacing all previous Master Plans for the Town of Tamworth; further the Planning Board does designate said master plan as the planning guideline to be consulted and followed in the performance of its duties; and agrees to implement, to the best of its abilities, the recommendations and policies contained in this plan for the coordinated and harmonious development of the Town of Tamworth.
