It was determined that significant research would be conducted within each committee in order to attain the information necessary to progress.

Much discussion ensued about the various ways this Committee could concurrently assist the existing businesses in Tamworth. Topics included: centralized human resource assistance, group health rates, and the development of a web-site that would enable the residents and businesses of our town –as well as those from neighboring towns! - to easily find the products and/or services offered by Tamworth businesses.
