Review Determinations & Add Justifications

1829-03-14-00 – still definitively unknown, but names and plot place it on Cloutier property heading NNW from Cleveland Hill Road and crossing west boundary.

1829-07-02-00 – Old Stage Road from Mersfelder's to top of McDaniel Hill. MacDonald is actually McDaniel. All other names fit.

1829-07-09-00 – Fowler's Mill Road from site of original bridge, cutting up behind David Halpin's and continuing north to Burton line. Plot fits well but doesn't reach town line. Geographical description fits; physical evidence still on ground.

1830-03-09-00 – Extension of Mason Hill Road to Mountain Road. Geographical description fits; Jim Shea reports the road is still followable.

1830-04-08-01 - Part of unknown 1829-03-14-00.

1830-04-08-02 – Great Hill Road from Village to bend by D. Little's. Names are in If Walls Could Speak.

1830-06-08-03 – TOC "North Trail" from Hemenway Road to west boundary of HSF. Plot fits perfectly. Road still there. Cellar hole where chimney called for. Also, see 1839-10-01-00.

1830-07-10-00 – Great Hill Road around bend near D. Little's. Cogswell in If Walls could speak. Plot fits bend in road.

1832-09-19-00 – Unknown. Right in downtown South Tamworth. Based on info from K Thompson and S. Stowbridge, likely to be diagonal road through Stowbridge lot.

1833-05-09-00 – Scott Road. Plot fits, geography fits.

1834-02-27-00 – Depot Road near Smith Flat. Plot fits, Oxbow mentioned.

1836-06-08-00 - Unknown

1837-08-31-00 – Mill Road, So. Tamworth. Plot, names and geogrphy fit.

1838-07-17-00 – Behind Barnstormers, names and geography fit.

1839-03-12-00 – Short road toward west from Bemis Farm, names fit

1839-09-07-00 - Gilman Valley Road. Plot fits, names and geography fit.

1839-10-01-00 – Extension of 1830-06-08-03, following North Trail, skirting Great Hill Pond and intersecting with the old route of Great Hill Road. Plot fits woods roads on Cave and the LIDAR map. Names fit Walling Map and If Walls Could Speak.
