Draft Minutes – October 1, 2014

Draft minutes to be reviewed and approved at a subsequent meeting

Call to Order – Meeting called to order at 7:04 pm. Members present were Paul King, David Halpin, David Little, Lori Gerard and Chris Conrod. Members absent: Bob Cottrell, Ron Remick, David Bowles.

Review Minutes – Minutes of 09/03/2014 accepted with the correction of the spelling of Great Hill Road.

Layout Sleuthing – Using the Mylar sheet over the town map, we continued reviewing and identifying road layouts and discontinuances, and related actions/votes. We plotted those that could be geographically identified.

Revisited Volume 6, 1909-03-09-11 – Discontinue; includes the Fowlers Mill old bridge, which was upstream of the current bridge, and a short stretch of road from the bridge to what is now Fowler's Mill Road.

Volume 7:

1920-03-09-9A – Discontinue; most likely a road from Ed Sandoz headed east; maybe to GHR near Dana Steele's?

1920-03-09-10 – Discontinue; the current road from Ed Sandoz to Great Hill Road.

1922-03-14-9A – Discontinue; Osgood Road, but how much? Depends on where Osgood lived.

1922-03-14-16 – Discontinued and accepted new route at the east end of Loring Road.

1923-03-13-4 – Raise funds for continuation of construction of the highway leading from Tamworth Village to Butler's Bridge, so called.

1923-03-13-11 – Discontinue; unknown, need to research Johnson Clark and “Lord place”.

1924-03-11-10 – Relocation at foot of Cleveland Hill to eliminate dangerous curve.

Revisited Volume 6 1917-03-13-16 – Discontinue; we had it as the Sandoz road at last meeting. Place names fit better for the road that starts at the sharp bend at Willie Farnum's on Great Hill Road and goes south to Brown Hill Road. Called “Dow Hill Road”.

Next meeting – Scheduled for 7:00 pm, November 5, 2014, at the Town House.
