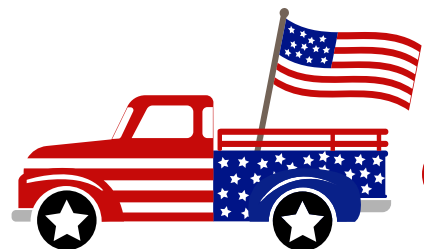
## Tamworth Parks & Recreation
