Transfer Station Study

As part of the Recycling Center Improvement Project for the Town of Tamworth, Sanborn Head & Associates Inc. prepared this transfer station study to support the proposed development of a new transfer station and recycling facility in Tamworth, New Hampshire.

The objectives of this study was to evaluate 1) the traffic flow at the transfer station and 2) monthly solid waste and recyclable data and utilize it to project future traffic flow and solid waste and recyclable materials generation rates, loose storage volumes, and baled storage volumes for development and sizing of the new transfer stations and recycling facility. This report summarizes the processes used to preform this study and the results.


