### **Styrofoam Recycling Drive June 3rd & 4th**

The Tamworth Recycling Project is holding a Styrofoam Recycling Drive at the Tamworth Transfer Station on Saturday, June 3rd and Sunday, June 4th, from 9:00am until 1:00pm each day. Please [click here](#) for details - and start saving your foam for recycling! All foam must be CLEAN - and no foam packing peanuts or pipe insulation can be accepted. When all the foam is collected, volunteers will take it to the Gilford Recycle Center, where the foam will be fed into a “densifier” and transformed into compact bricks which can then be made into a variety of products.

We’re looking for a few more volunteers to help with collecting the foam at the Transfer Station on June 3rd or 4th. It’s a fun way to connect with neighbors - and help keep this troublesome material out of the waste stream!
