- \$215,657 received from the State of New Hampshire as additional Highway Block Grant and Bridge Aid funds
- \$322,130 in unanticipated revenue received from the State of New Hampshire American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA)

- Print and share options

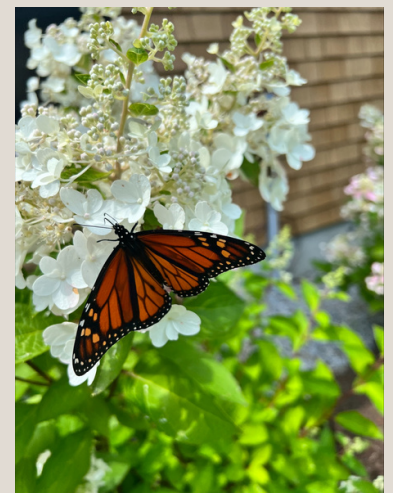
