

# Forest Service News Release - Sandwich Vegetation Management Project Final Environmental Assessment - 45day objection period

The White Mountain National Forest (WMNF) is issuing a draft decision on the Sandwich Vegetation Management Project (Sandwich VMP), along with a Final Environmental Assessment (EA). The WMNF has also reached a Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI). The Draft Decision Notice incorporates all information included in the Sandwich VMP EA/FONSI, the project record, and stakeholder input.

The best available science, including climate change science, has informed the environmental analysis and the project design to maximize benefits to the environment, and people for the long term. We are observing a decline in forest health, and climate change models show that we can expect more intense periods of droughts, floods, and other stressors that are likely to accelerate the decline in forest health. The Sandwich VMP will ensure a healthy and sustainable forest for the future by increasing diversity and improving forest resilience to threats posed by climate change, non-native species, and insects and disease. Inaction is not a viable option for ensuring long term forest health and sustainability, and is not consistent with agency and Forest goals.

The Final EA, FONSI, and Draft Decision Notice incorporates public input from the pre-scoping open house that was held in January 2020, the 30-day scoping period which was initiated in 2022, and the additional two 30-day comment periods that were offered for the draft EA in summer of 2023. There have been no major changes to the proposed action from scoping to the final EA. Minor changes include refinements of units and prescriptions, and clarifications regarding the intent of the project and anticipated effects. "We've worked to address the concerns of the public through virtual and inperson meetings, as well as onsite field trips, while ensuring we use the most recent science to restore and maintain a mix of forest conditions that support biological diversity and improve the overall health of this valued landscape," said District Ranger Jim Innes.

The legal notice published in the New Hampshire Union Leader and the Conway Daily Sun, officially begins the 45-day objection period. 
