The Energy Committee is hosting the first of two Public Hearings on Tamworth Community Power on October 17th at the Town House at 7:00 pm. All electricity customers are encouraged to attend to learn about the proposed plan to create Tamworth Community Power. The aim is to help electricity customers save money on the supply of their electricity and increase their renewable energy options. The Public Hearings are part of the preparations for bringing a warrant article on Tamworth Community Power to Town meeting in the spring. The one and a half hour Public Hearing will include hand-outs, presentations and a public question and answer period. There will be a zoom option. 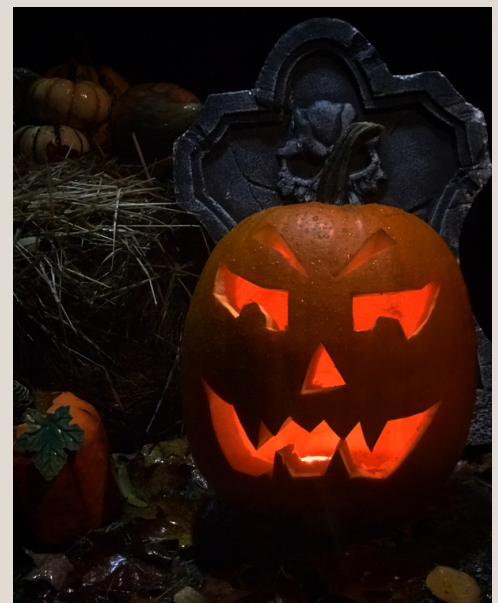

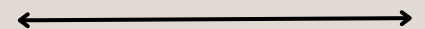
