Reminder: Dog Licensing Expires April 30th

LICENSING OF DOGS-provide current rabies certificate; expired certificates will not be accepted Dog Licensing begins in January of each Calendar Year Dog licenses expire on April 30th of every year. All dogs are required to be licensed per state law RSA 466:1

LICENSE FEES:

- \$9.00 per Unaltered dog
- \$6.50 per Spayed or Neutered dog
- \$6.50 per Puppy 4-7 months
- Senior Citizen Owner aged 65 and older pays \$2.00 for first dog registered
- \$20.00 per Group License (5 of more dogs)

Transfer and Recycling Station.

All dogs are to be licensed by April 30th of every year. As of June 1st, you will be charged a late fee of \$1.00 per month for every month you are late licensing your dog. State Law requires that notification be given to the Tamworth Police Dept. of violations to RSA 466:1. A \$30.00 Civil Forfeiture fine can be issued to offenders who do not license their dog within the deadline
