Dumping by permit only - A Transfer Station Permit
sticker or Non Resident Temporary Permit

DIRECTIONS to facility: The Transfer Station is located at
550 Ossipee Mountain Highway (Rte 25) From
the intersection of 16 & 25 it is 3.3 miles on the
left hand side, and from the intersection of 113
and 25 it is 1 mile on the right hand side.

The Following Must be Recycled:

Aluminum cans - (Beverage cans only)
Corrugated cardboard - must be flattened (no waxed cardboard or pizza boxes)
Batteries – all rechargeable
Brush (5" diameter max.)
White Goods: (Washers, Dryers, Ranges, Water heaters, etc.)
Steel & Tin Cans (Must be rinsed clean)
Glass (Must be rinsed clean and lids removed)

The following will not be accepted anywhere in the Transfer Station:
Hazardous Waste-Stumps-Pine Needles-Lawn Clippings-Leaves
Other Yard & Garden Debris, Propane Cylinders, Automobile Batteries
& Animal and/or Human Waste.

**Scrap Metals
Recycling Guidelines**

Acceptable:

White Goods: (Washers, Dryers, Ranges, Water heaters, etc.)
Units with Freon include a fee (see fee schedule)

Not Acceptable:

Anything containing fuel or oils must be drained before disposing.

Summary: Household Hazardous Waste

Hazardous Materials are **not accepted at the Transfer Station.**

***Anything with labels warning** Acid, Caustic, Flammable, Pesticide, Poison, Toxic is a Hazardous Material

**** Latex paint is not hazardous.** After drying with paint hardener or by mixing with sawdust or kitty litter it is demolition debris.

Hazardous Materials are accepted at **Household Hazardous Waste collections.**

Last Saturday of July & First Saturday of August, 8:30-Noon

Collections are never held at the Tamworth Transfer Station. Brochures available each summer or go to lakesrpc.org.

July: Belmont, Franklin, Gilford, Meredith **August:** Bristol, Center Ossipee, Laconia, Moultonborough

Businesses: Dispose of hazardous materials at fee-based Lakes Region Household Hazardous Products Facility

Open the third Saturday of each month, May-October, 8:30 a.m.-Noon

*****Medications** (not liquids) can be dropped into secure collection boxes any time Moultonborough or Conway Police Departments are open. (No questions asked. No fee.) Other locations are available twice a year during the Drug Enforcement Agency's Drug Take-Back Days in the spring and fall. (No questions asked. No fee.) Medications are also accepted at the fee-based Lakes Region Household Hazardous Products Facility (see above) *only in June and August.*
