Members Present: Mark Albee, John Roberts and John Wheeler

- 1) The minutes of 04/12/17 meeting were approved.
- 2) John Wheeler remains as Chairman and secretary, Mark as overseer of contractors.
- 3) Cemeteries appear to be in good shape for Memorial Day. Flags have been placed on veterans' graves with the help of the Boy Scouts and David Haskell.
- 4) Recent contacts:
  - a) John W will meet with Mark Butterfield 5/25 at Pease Cemetery re his father's proposed burial.
  - b) The question of sale of lots to non-residents was discussed again. The rules and regulations were voted to be changed back to include a fee of \$1200 for a burial lot for non-residents.
  - c) John W reported that he had had contact with Susan McMullen Hughes, Marion Steele and Jean Terhume (sp?) concerning burial of a relative of Hughes in the old Section of Chocorua Cemetery. The lot was found in the western section. Ashes will be interred June 29.
  - d) John W happened to meet with Peter Dancy, owner of the property north and east of the Chocorua Cemetery. Peter had hired a surveyor to find the western cemetery boundary with his property as Peter had done some clearing on both sides of the line. Peter provided photos of portions of the Tall Pines subdivision plan 4/28/1988. The boundary markers were found and some of the Town's land had had brush removed by Peter. John W will draft a letter to Peter.
  - e) Judy McLean of the Bearcamp Valley Gardeners has contacted Mark and indicated their membership has declined and they did not have enough members available to water the Veterans Memorial as often as may be needed, but they would plant the flowers. Mark will work on finding other volunteers to fill in.
  - f) Mark and John R will place the corner markers for the Alt site in the green burial area at Ordination Rock. They will also place corner markers for the Hudak site (F27 and F28) in Wonalancet Cemetery due to a request from the Hudaks.
  - g) There are presently no items to report to the Capital Improvements Program. The Chapman cemetery fence in Chocorua Village needs work, but ownership needs to be determined and then plans made.
- 5) The annual AG's training session for Trustees announcement has been received. Mark may be able to go to the short session in Bartlett and John W to the longer session in Concord.
- 6) The next meeting will be at 5:30 PM, June 28, at Cook Library.
